92. (WS). Join **LEMON** and SC in each ST across.

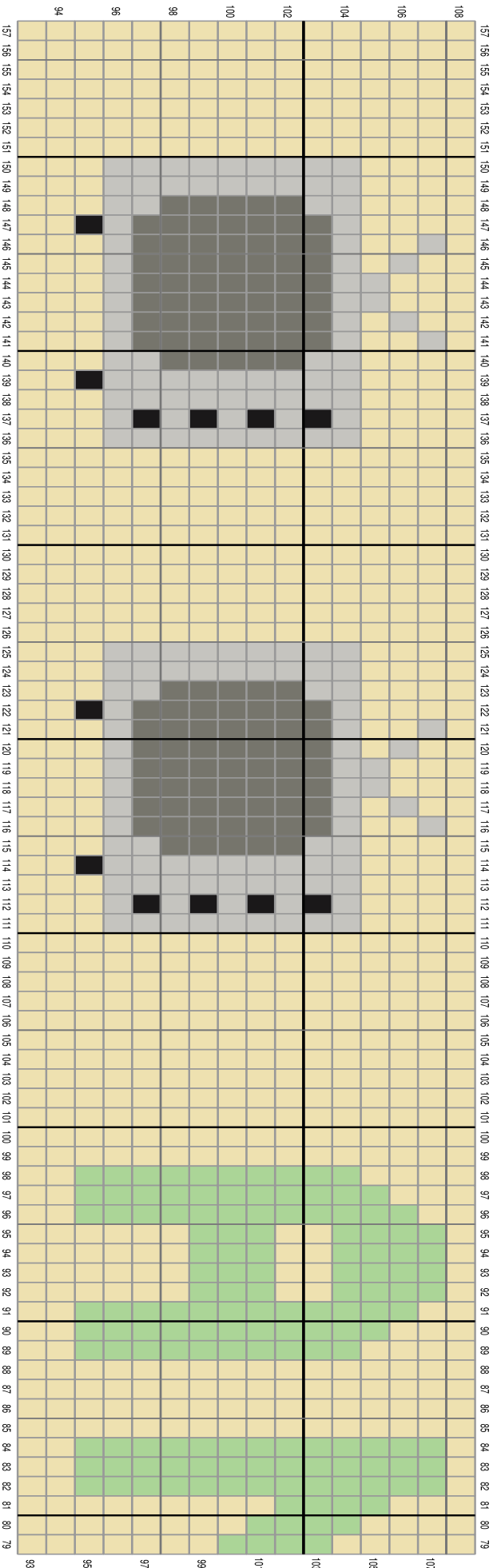
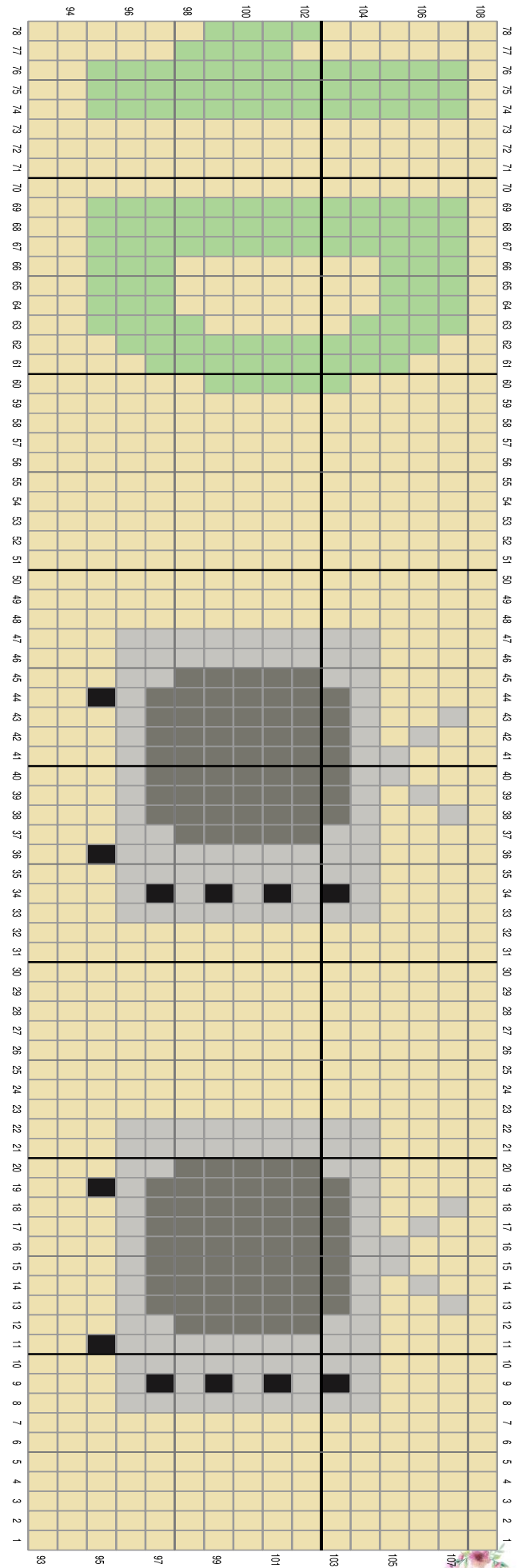
93. **TV section.** Follow chart and colour blocks pattern from **ROW 93**. The numbers within the colour blocks indicate how many stitches to make in that colour. **Each ST is a SC.** Change Colour in the last part of the ST before the colour change.

**Tip** – use bobbins for small amounts of yarn. I did carry the yarn behind for the 2 TV's and had separate bobbins for the next set of TV's. I didn't carry the black across for the legs as I felt this would show through the stitches. I fastened the yarn off after each leg. For the TV button I kept a separate black bobbin for each TV and carried the yarn up for each of the TV buttons.

109. (RS). Continuing in **LEMON**, SC in each ST across.

110. (WS). SC in each ST across.

111. (RS). **FLORET STITCH SECTION**. - CH3 - counts as 1<sup>st</sup> DC. DC in each ST across.

112. (WS). CH1 – counts as 1<sup>st</sup> SLST. \* DC in the next ST. SLST in the next ST. *Take care not to make SLST's too tight.* Repeat from \* across finishing with a SLST in the top of the CH3.

113. (RS). CH3 - counts as 1<sup>st</sup> DC. DC in each DC and each SLST across finishing with a DC in the CH1. Fasten off **LEMON**.

114. (WS). Join **APRICOT** CH1 – counts as 1<sup>st</sup> SLST. \* DC in the next ST. SLST in the next ST. *Take care not to make SLST's too tight.* Repeat from \* across finishing with a SLST in the top of the CH3.

115. (RS). CH3 - counts as 1<sup>st</sup> DC. DC in each DC and each SLST across finishing with a DC in the CH1

116. (WS). Continuing with **APRICOT** - Repeat **ROW 114**.

117. (RS). Repeat **ROW 115**.

118. (WS). (CH1, SC). SC in each ST across finishing with a SC in the top of the CH3.



119. (RS). Follow CHART for **WATCH NETFLIX** section starting at **ROW 119**. Each ST is a SC. The numbers in the coloured blocks represents how many SC stitches in make in that colour. Change colour in the last part of the ST before the colour change.

**WISTERIA LETTERS STS ONLY** are worked in the **BACK LOOPS** when working on the **RS** of work and in the **FRONT LOOPS**

when working on the **WS** of work. **APRICOT STS** are worked in **BOTH LOOPS**. (This gives the writing an inset look).

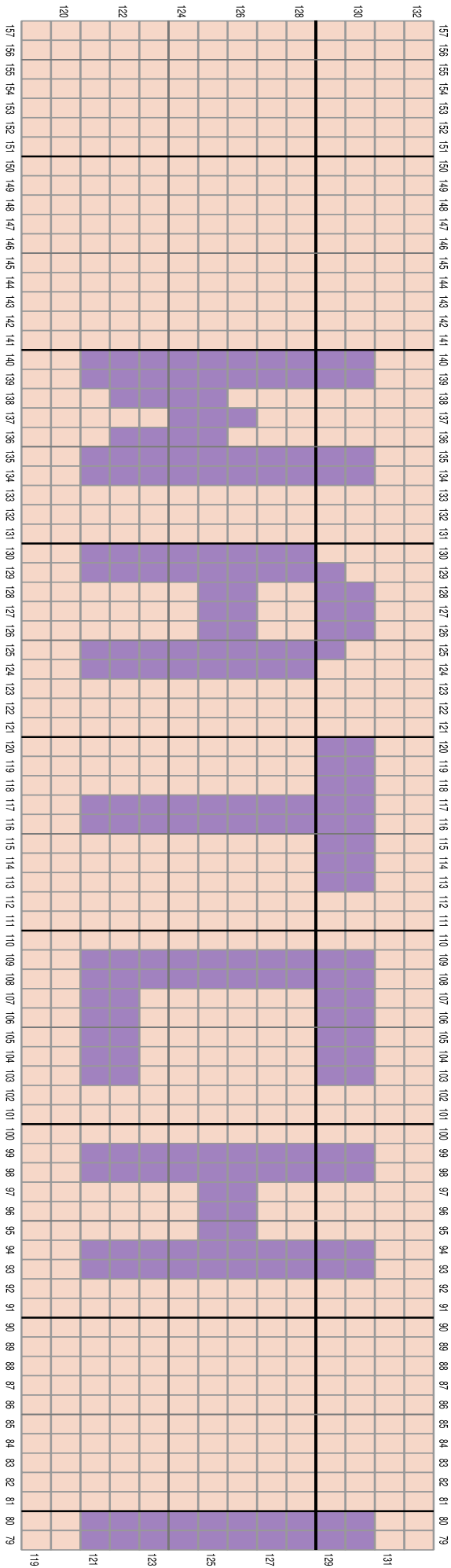
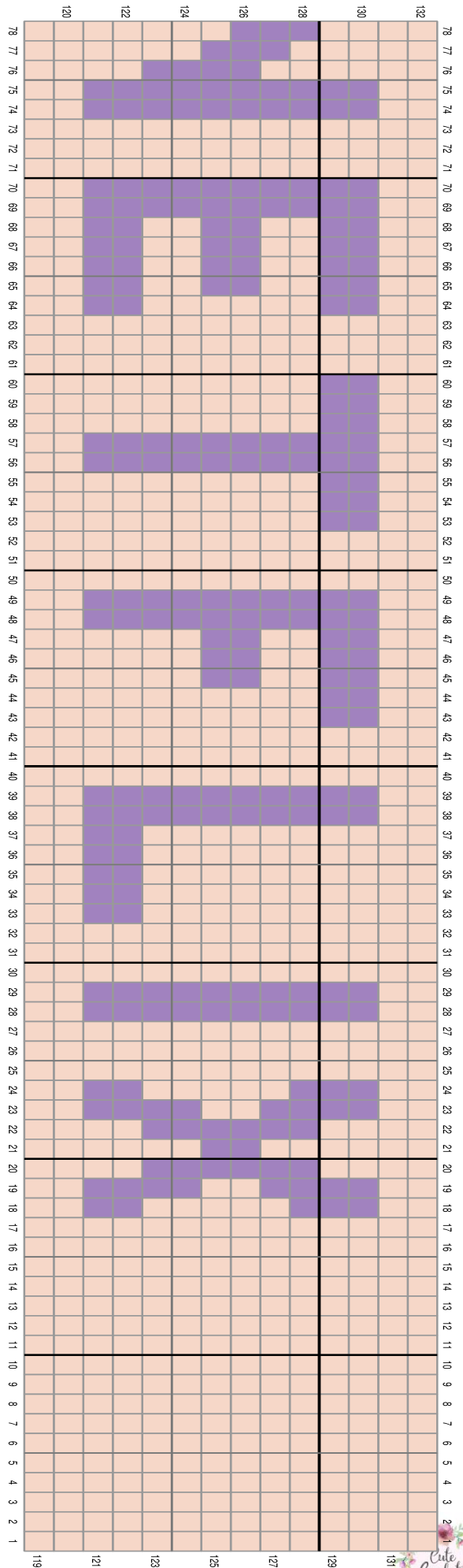

135. (RS). **SUZETTE STITCH SECTION.** Continuing in **APRICOT** CH1 – *do this at the start - does not count as a ST throughout the next few rows.* (SC, DC) in the 1<sup>st</sup> ST. \* Skip a ST. (SC, DC) in the following ST. Repeat from \* across finishing with just a SC in the last ST.



136. (WS). (SC, DC). \* Skip the DC ST from the previous row . Make (SC, DC) in the next SC ST from the previous row. Repeat from \* across. Finishing with just a SC in the last ST. Fasten off **APRICOT**.



137. (RS). Join **SPRING GREEN** (SC, DC) in the 1<sup>st</sup> ST. \* Skip a ST. (SC, DC) in the following ST. Repeat from \* across finishing with just a SC in the last ST.



138. (WS). (SC, DC). \* Skip the DC ST from the previous row . Make (SC, DC) in the next SC ST from the previous row. Repeat from \* across finishing with just a SC in the last ST.

139. (RS). SC in each ST across.

140. (WS). SC in each ST across.

141. (RS). **MINI BEAN (ELIZABETH STITCH) SECTION.** SC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST. MB – mini bean in the next ST. *To make the Mini bean ST (MB) insert hook into ST, YO, pull up a loop. YO and insert hook back into the same ST, YO, pull up a loop, YO and pull through all 4 loops on hook.* \* CH1, Skip the next ST. MB into the following ST. Repeat from \* across finishing with a SC in the last ST .

142. (WS). – 154 (WS). SC in 1<sup>st</sup> ST. MB in the 1<sup>st</sup> MB ST, \* CH1. Skip next CH1 space. MB in next MB. Repeat from \* across finishing with a SC in the last ST. *(Make the MB in the small gap to the side of the MB).*

143. (RS). – 144. (WS). SC in each ST and CH1 space across. Fasten off yarn.

Weave in ends. **Part 3 complete.**
