



Tip – use bobbins for small amounts of yarn. I did carry the yarn behind for the 2 TV's and had separate bobbins for the next set of TV's. I didn't carry the black across for the legs as I felt this would show through the stitches. I fastened the yarn off after each leg. For the TV button I kept a separate black bobbin for each TV and carried the yarn up for each of the TV buttons.

(This gives the writing an inset look).







- **138.** (WS). (SC, DC). * Skip the DC ST from the previous row. Make (SC, DC) in the next SC ST from the previous row. Repeat from * across finishing with just a SC in the last ST.
