Sweet Dreams Cloud

Hook size : 3mm & 4mm Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK in Candyfloss, Spring Green, Sherbet, Apricot, Wisteria, White & Black.

This pattern is written in US terms

Square - Use 4mm hook

- Using WISTERIA in a MR, CH5 counts as DC and CH2, then in ring (3DC, CH2) 3 times. CH2, 2DC and SLST into the 3rd ST of the beg CH5. (4 sides of 3DC with CH2 between)
- SLST twice into the previous round CH2 space. (CH5, 2DC) in the same CH2 space. * 1DC in each ST across with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in the corner space Repeat from * around finishing in the beg corner space with 1DC. SLST into the 3rd CH of the beg CH5 to join. (Each side has 7DC with CH2 in each corner).
- **3. 5.** Repeat Row 2. Making 1DC into each ST with (2DC, CH2 2DC) into each corner. Fasten off yarn. (Row 5 Each side has 19DC with CH2 in each corner).
- 6. Join WHITE in any corner space. (CH3- *counts as DC*, 1DC, CH2, 2DC), * CH1, miss 1ST, DC in the next ST. Repeat from across * finishing with CH1, skip a ST and make (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in the corner CH2 space. Repeat from * around. SLST in the 3rd CH of the beg CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 13DC with CH1 and CH2 between in corners).
- Join WISTERIA in any corner space. (CH1 -does not count as a ST, 2SC, CH2, 2SC). * SC in each ST and CH space across with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) in the corner space. Repeat from * around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off yarn (Each side has 27SC with CH2 in each corner).

Raindrops - Use 3mm hook and make 4 (SHERBET, CANDY FLOSS, SPRING GREEN & APRICOT)

- 1. In a MR make 6SC. SLST in 1st SC made to join (6sts).
- 2. (CH1 does not count as a ST throughout pattern, 2SC), (2SC) in each ST around. SLST in 1st SC to join. (12sts).
- **3.** (CH1, SC), (HDC, CH3, SLST into 3rd CH from the hook), HDC, SC. SLST around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew rain drops onto the square.

<u>Cloud</u>

- 1. Using a 4mm hook and WHITE yarn loosely CH17. SC in 2nd CH from hook and in each ST across .(16sts)
- 2. 6. Turn, CH1-(do this for each of the following rows. CH1 does not count as a ST). SC in each ST across. (16sts)
- 7. (CH1, SC), HDC, DC, (4TR), DC, HDC, SC, SC, HDC, DC, (2TR), (4DTR), (2TR), DC, HDC, SC. Working down the side of the cloud, SLST, SC, HDC, (4DC), HDC, (2SC). SC in each ST across the bottom ending with (2SC) in the last ST. Working up the side of the cloud SC, HDC, (2DC), HDC, SC, SLST. SLST in the 1st SC made to join. (58sts). Do not turn work.
- (CH1, SC), SC in each ST around the whole cloud but SLST into ST between the cloud top and side curves. See photo arrows.
 SLST into the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail.





Cheeks - make 2. Use a 3mm hook and CANDYFLOSS yarn.

- 1. In a MR make 5SC. SLST in 1st SC made to join. (5sts)
- (CH1, 2SC), (2SC) in each ST around. SLST in 1st SC to join. Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew cheeks on to the cloud. (10sts). Sew cheeks onto the cloud so that the bottom of the cheeks are 2 rows from the bottom of the cloud and the sides are just touching the side of the curved stitches.



Using black yarn, insert needle in the 6th Row above the cheeks, skip 2 stitches and thread yarn back through. To make the eyelashes bring the needle through the middle of the black yarn and go back down in the stitch below to anchor it. Repeat twice more. Repeat for the other eye.

For the mouth sew a line 2 stitches apart between the cheeks. Again, thread the needle back through the middle of the mouth, and into the stitch below to secure a smiley mouth. Fasten off and cut yarn.



Sew Cloud onto square so that the bottom of the cloud sits on the start of round 2. Try to sew through the top stitches of the square so that no white yarn is seen at the back of the square. Sew on raindrops in a staggered effect like in the main photo.

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
