

Flower Blanket – Double Daisy Square

Hook size: 4.5mm for all parts.

Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK in Fondant, Soft Peach, White and Sunshine.

This pattern is written in US terms

US Terminology

SC – single crochet

HDC - half double crochet

DC – double crochet

FPDC – front post double crochet

BPDC - back post double crochet

SLST – slip stitch

MR – magic ring

CH – chain

ST - stitch

() – indicate all stitches to be made in one stitch.

Gauge is 17 stitches x 10 rows = 10cm. (Rows of DC).

Granny Square – Use FONDANT

1. In a MR, CH5 (*Counts as 1st DC and CH2*), (3DC, CH2) 3 times. Then 2DC and SLST into the 3rd ST of the beginning CH5.
2. **TURN** work, CH3 (*Counts as 1st DC*). Make 1DC in each ST around with (2DC, CH2, 2DC) in the corner chain spaces. SLST in top of CH3 to join. (Each side has 7DC with CH2 between).
3. **to 7.** Repeat Row 2. SLST in top of CH3 to join. Fasten off yarn. (Row 7 will have 27DC on each side with CH2 between).

Daisy Flower – Use SUNSHINE

1. In a MR make 16DC. SLST to 1st DC to join. (16 Stitches).
2. CH2 (*Does not count as a ST*), then *FPDC around 1st DC, BPDC around next DC. Repeat around SLST in top of the first FPDC to join. (16 stitches).
3. (CH1,SC). Then SC in each ST around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC. (This will make the centre of the daisy lift up.) Fasten off leaving a long tail to sew flower onto square. (16 Stitches).
4. Working in the **FRONT LOOPS** only of Row 3, Join **WHITE** yarn in any ST. *CH8, then SC in 2nd CH from hook and in the next 6 stitches down the chain. SLST into the next SC stitch. Repeat *around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC. Fasten off yarn. (16 petals made).
5. Working in the **BACK LOOPS** only of Row 3. Push petals forward and join **SOFT PEACH** in the back loop of the 1st SC, *CH 10 then SC1 in the 2nd CH from the hook, HDC in the next 8 stitches down the chain. SLST into next SC and repeat from* ending with a SLST in the 1st CH of the 1st petal made. Fasten off yarn. (16 petals made).

Place Daisy in the centre of the square. Use the lemon long tail to sew the daisy onto the square. Only sew a round of stitches through Row 3 so that the petals will naturally curl up.
