Shooting Star Square

Hook size: 3mm & 4mm

Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK in White, Lemon, Spring Green, Sherbet,

Apricot, Wisteria and Clematis.

This pattern is written is US terms

US Terminology UK Terminology

SC – single crochet DC

HDC – half double crochet HTR
DC – double crochet TR

SLST – slip stitch ST - stitch MR – magic ring CH – chain

() – indicate all stitches to be made in one stitch.

Gauge - 19 stitches over 11 rows = 10cm (Rows of DC). Finished blocked square measures 12cm x 12cm.



To make the block granny square use 4mm hook. - Use WHITE yarn

- 1. In a MR, CH5. In ring make (3DC, CH2) 3 times. CH2, 2DC and SLST into the 3rd ST of the CH5. (4 sides of 3DC with CH2 between).
- 2. SLST twice into the previous round CH2 space. CH5, then 2DC in the same CH2 space. 1DC into each of the next 3 stitches. (2DC, CH2, 2DC) into the corner space Repeat for the next 3 sides. Finish with 1DC in the last corner and SLST into the 3rd ST of beginning CH5. (4 sides of 7DC with CH 2 between).
- 3. 6. Repeat the above. Making 1DC into each ST with (2DC, CH2 2DC) into each corner. (4sides of 23 stitches with CH2 between).
- 7. SLST twice into the previous round chain, (CH1, SC1, CH2 then 2SC into the same space). SC1 in each ST with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) in the corner space. Repeat along finishing with 1SC in last space then SLST into the beginning CH1. Fasten off and sew in ends. (4 sides of 27 stitches with CH2 between).

<u>Star</u>

Using <u>LEMON</u> yarn and a **3MM** hook, make a star from the above pattern. Leave a long tail for sewing star onto square.

Rainbow - Use 3MM Hook

(CH3 counts as a stitch).

- 1. Using WISTERIA CH12. SC1 in 2nd CH from hook and in next 7 stitches, HDC, HDC, DC. (11 stitches).
- 2. (CH3 Turn, SC1 in same ST), SC1 across. Fasten off yarn. (12 stitches).
- **3. Turn** join **CLEMATIS** in the last SC from the previous row. (CH1, SC) (CH1 does not count as a ST). SC in next 8 stitches, HDC, HDC, (DC in top of CH3). (12 stitches).
- **4.** (CH3 **Turn**, SC1 in same stitch), SC1 across, 2SC in the last ST. Fasten off yarn. (14 stitches).
- **5. Turn** join **SHERBET** in last SC from previous row. (CH1, SC1). SC1 in next 10 stitches, HDC, HDC, (DC in top of CH3). (14 stitches).
- **6.** (CH3 **Turn**, SC1 in same ST), SC1 across, 3SC in the last ST. Fasten off yarn.(17 stitches).
- **7. Turn** join **SPRING GREEN** in the last SC from the previous row. (CH1, SC1). SC1 in next 13 stitches, HDC, HDC, (DC in top of CH3). (17 stitches).
- **8.** (CH3 **Turn**, SC1 in same ST), SC1 across, 2SC in last ST. Fasten off yarn.(19 stitches).
- **9. Turn** join LEMON in last SC from the previous row. (CH1, SC1). SC1 in next 15 stitches, HDC, HDC, (DC in top of CH3). (19 stitches).
- 10. (CH3 Turn, SC1 in same stitch), SC1 across, 3SC in the last ST. Fasten off yarn. (22 stitches).
- **11. Turn** join APRICOT in last SC from previous row. (CH1, SC1). SC1 in the next 18 stitches, HDC, HDC, (DC in top of CH3). (22 stitches).
- 12. (CH3, Turn, SC1 in same ST), SC1 across, 3SC in last ST. Fasten off yarn. (25 stitches).

Sew in ends. Pin star slightly overlapping rainbow onto square. Use long tail off star to sew the star on, going through the rainbow as well. Sew around the rainbow catching in the back loops of the rainbow so that the stitches don't show through the rainbow.
