## Crossed Cowl

Hook size: 5mm

Yarn: Scheepjes Chunky monkey (Aran)

• 1 ball of Petrol

• 1 ball of Carolina Blue

## This pattern is written is US terms

US TerminologyUK TerminologySC - single crochetDCHDC - half double crochetHDCDC - double crochetTR

CH – chain ST – stitch

XDC – cross double crochet XTR (see notes in pattern)



- 1. Using PETROL CH192.
- 2. Make 1HDC in the 3<sup>RD</sup> CH from the hook and in each ST across. (191 stitches).
- 3. Turn CH3 counts as DC. \* Skip the next ST and the work 1DC in the following ST (the 3<sup>rd</sup> ST from the end). Then work 1DC in the skipped ST. (the 2<sup>nd</sup> ST from the end). This has created a cross DC (XDC). Repeat from \* creating XDC across. Fasten off yarn, leave enough yarn to sew ends together later. (95XDC made and CH3, 191 stitches)
- **4.** Join **CAROLINA BLUE** in the **BACK LOOP** of the 1<sup>st</sup> ST on **RIGHT** side of work. CH2. \* Skip the next ST and make 1HDC in between the XDC from the previous row. HDC in the back loop of the next ST. Repeat from \* across. (191 stitches).
- 5. Turn, (CH1 does not count as a ST, SC). Make 1SC in each ST across. (191 stitches).
- 6. Turn, CH2 counts as 1<sup>st</sup> HDC. Make 1HDC in the *BACK* loops of each ST across. (191 stitches).
- **7.** Repeat Row 6.
- 8. Repeat Row 3. Fasten off yarn. (190 stitches).
- 13. Join PETROL on RIGHT side of work. Repeat Rows 4 8. Fasten off yarn. (190 stitches).
- **14. 15.** Join CAROLINA BLUE on *RIGHT* side of work. Repeat Rows 4 5. Fasten off yarn. Place wrong sides together and using the tail ends sew through the back loops of each side to join.







The Mustard/Cream/Grey cowls I made using Chunky wool. They used 1 ball of each colour.
