

Unicorn Dreams Blanket

Butterfly Square

Hook size: 4mm

Yarn: Stylecraft Special DK in Sherbet, Wisteria and Clematis.

This pattern is written in US terms

US Terminology

SC – single crochet

HDC – half double crochet

DC – double crochet

SLST – slip stitch

MR – magic ring

CH – chain

ST - stitch

() – indicate all stitches to be made in one stitch.

Gauge - 19 stitches over 11 rows = 10cm (Rows of DC).

Finished blocked square measures 12cmx12cm.

Bordered Granny Square

Use **SHERBET** Yarn.

1. In a MR CH3 (*counts as 1st DC throughout pattern*). In ring make, 2DC, CH2, (3DC, CH2) 3 times. SLST in top of beginning CH3 to join. (20 stitches).
2. (CH3, 2DC), in next CH2 space make *(3DC, CH2, 3DC). Repeat in the next 2 CH2 spaces. 3DC, CH2, SLST to top of beginning CH3. (32 stitches, 8 lots of 3DC).
3. (CH3, 2DC). Then make *3DC in between the 3DC,'s from the previous round. (3DC, CH2, 3DC) in corner space. Repeat * round finishing with (3DC, CH2. SLST in the top of beginning CH3 to join). (44 stitches, 12 lots of 3DC).
4. **To 6.** Repeat Row3. (Row 6 – each side has 6 lots of 3DC with CH2 in each corner).
7. Relaxing tension slightly. (CH1 - *does not count as a ST*, SC), *SC in each ST across with (SC, CH2, SC) in each corner space. Repeat around finishing in the 1st CH space with 1SC, CH2 and SLST to 1st SC made to join. (Each side has 20SC with CH2 between).
8. Repeat Row 7. (Each side has 22SC with CH2 between).
9. (CH1, 2SC) Make *1SC in each ST across with (2SC, CH2, 2SC) in each corner space. Repeat around finishing in the 1st CH space with SC, CH2. SLST to 1st SC to join. Fasten off yarn. (Each side has 26SC with CH2 between).

Butterfly Pattern

Use **4MM** hook. Make 2.

I purchased the elegance butterfly pattern from Andreea Necula of Gloriousunique because I loved the shape of the butterfly.

Butterfly 1. I used **WISTERIA** for PART A and **CLEMATIS** for PART B.

Butterfly 2. I used **CLEMATIS** for PART A and **WISTERIA** for PART B.

Pin butterflies onto square at angles (see photo). Sew butterflies on going through the top of the stitches on the square, so that the stitches do not show through the back of the square.
