

SWEETHEART BLANKET

YARN

Aldi Chunky 100g Baby Yarn 100% Polyester yarn

(Chunky – Weight 5) 100g = 68 meters

4 balls of Blue - 337g used

4 balls of White - 373g used

HOOK - 8mm

Blanket measures – approx. 71cm x 71cm

This crochet pattern uses US crochet terms.

ABBREVIATIONS

CH = Chain

SC = Single Crochet

B = Bobble Stitch

SLST = Slip Stitch

[] = Repeat Pattern

(RS) = Right Side of Work

(WS) = Wrong Side of Work

BOBBLE STITCH - This ST will always be worked on the **WRONG SIDE** of your work. Yarn over (YO), insert hook into ST, pull up a loop. YO, and pull through 2 loops - 2 loops on hook. Repeat 3 more times in the same ST - 5 loops on hook. YO and pull through all 5 loops. Fasten off bobble colour at the end of each row.

COLOUR CHANGES

Always change colour in the last YO of the stitch before the allocated colour change.

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The Sweetheart Blanket is made up of 4 squares – 2 squares of each heart design.

1. **(RS).** CH26. SC in the 2nd CH from the hook and in each CH across - this will be Row 1 on the chart.
2. **(WS).** CH1 and turn – do this for each of the following rows. CH1 does not count as St throughout. *Each row has 25sts throughout the pattern.*
3. **(RS). – 25. (RS).** Follow the following charts to Row 25.



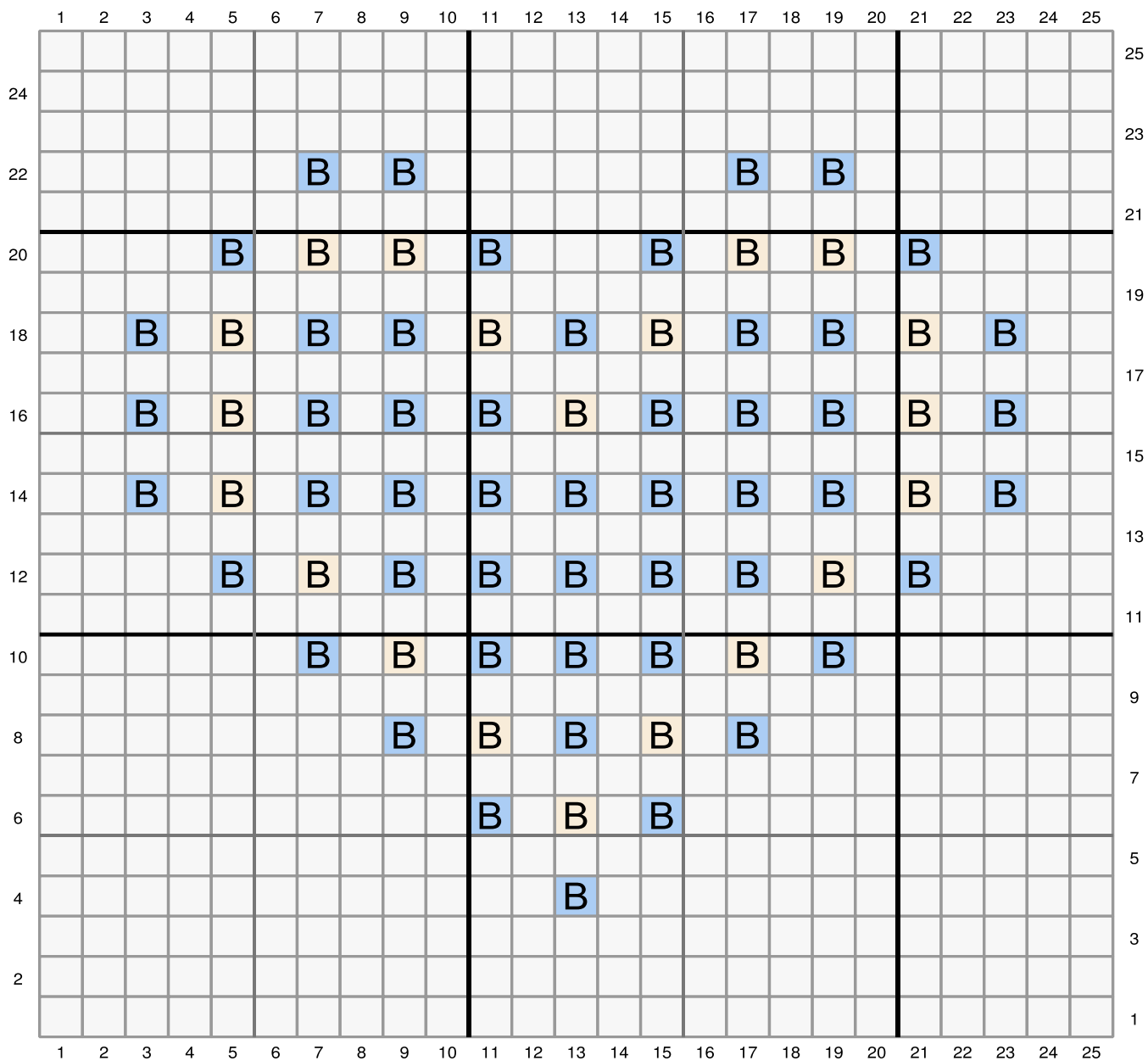
CH1, rotate work and make 1SC in each row end. CH1, rotate work and make 1SC in ST across. CH1, rotate work and make 1SC in each row end up. CH1 and SLST in the 1st SC made to join. *Each side has 25sts with CH1 in each corner.*

26. **(RS).** – 27. **(RS).** (CH1, SC). * SC in each ST across with (SC, CH1, SC) in the CH1 space. Repeat from * around. SLST in the 1st SC made to join. Fasten off yarn. Row 27 - *each side has 29sts with CH1 in each corner.*

JOINING THE SQUARES TOGETHER

1. Place RS of squares together. Using WHITE and starting in the 1st ST of the side of the squares, SC through both loops of each square. Repeat until the 2 squares are joined together vertically. Fasten off yarn.
2. Rejoin WHITE and repeat Row 1 joining the squares horizontally.
3. **(RS).** Rejoin WHITE in any corner space with a SC. * SC in each ST across the 1st square. SC2TOG over the CH1 on this square and the 2nd square. SC in each ST across the 2nd Square. (SC, CH1, SC) in the corner space. Repeat from * around only finishing in the beginning corner space with a (SC, CH1) and SLST in the 1st SC made to join.
4. **(WS).** Turn work. SLST into the CH1 space. (CH1, SC). * SC in each ST across with (SC, CH1, SC) in the corner space. Repeat from * around only finishing in the beginning corner space with a (SC, CH1) and SLST in the 1st SC made to join.
5. **(RS).** Turn work and repeat round 4. Fasten off yarn.
6. **(RS).** Join BLUE in any corner space and repeat round 4.
7. **(RS).** **BORDER** - SLST into the corner space. CH2. Skip the next ST. * SLST, CH2. Skip the next ST. Repeat from * around making a SLST, CH2 in each CH1 space. SLST in the 1st SLST made to join. Fasten off yarn. Weave in ends.

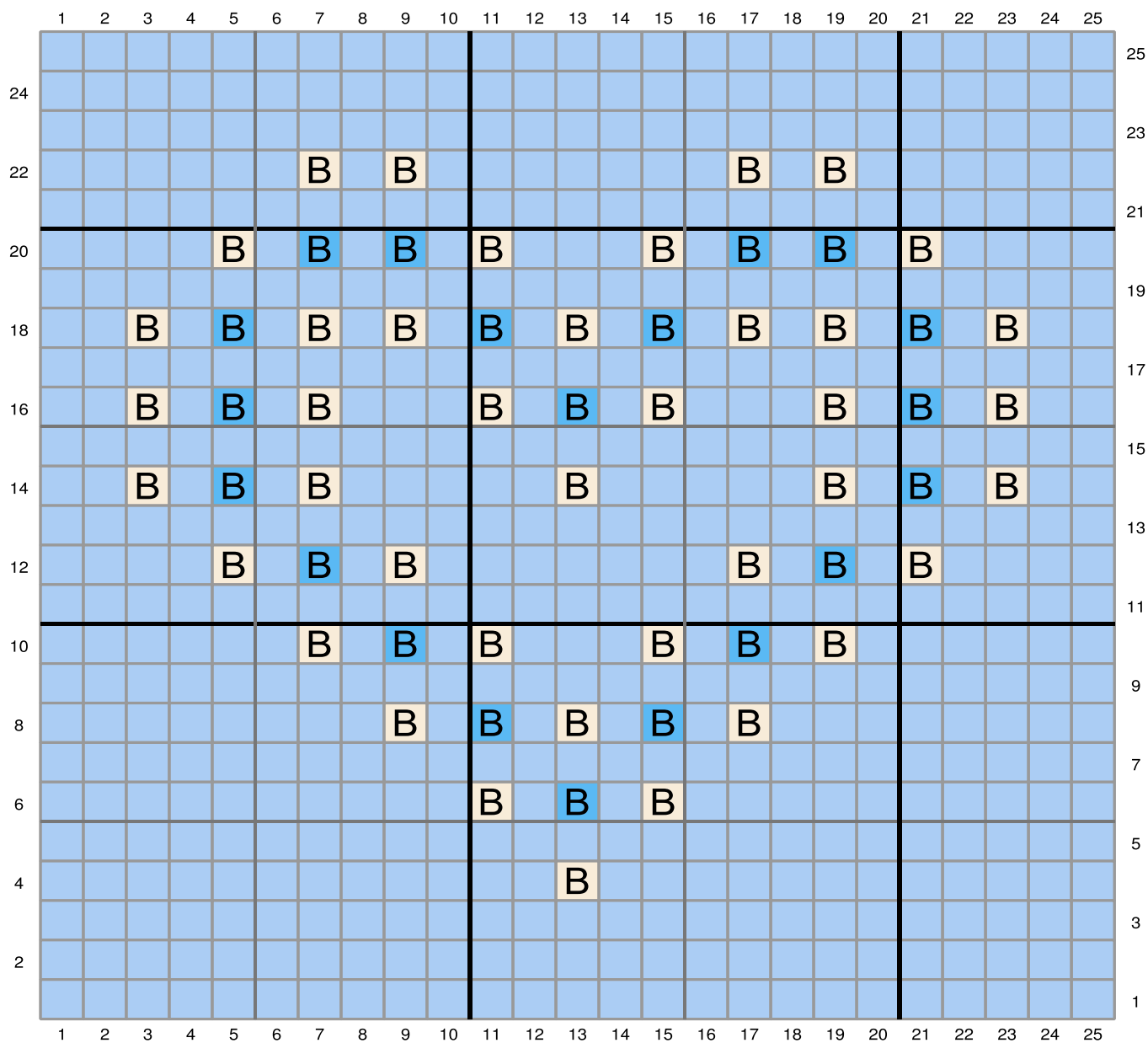
