



Frosted Icicle Mitts

Crochet Pattern

(As Seen in Crochet Society Box & Crochet Now Magazine)

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YARN – Bella Coco DK. 110m per 50g ball. 100% acrylic.

1 ball of White • 1 ball of Grey • 1 ball of Mustard • 1 ball of Blue

CROCHET HOOK

4mm

ABBREVIATIONS – ***This pattern is written in UK terms***

DC = Double Crochet

HTR = Half Double Crochet

ST(s)= Stitch(es)

SLST = Slip Stitch

FPHTR – Front Post Half Treble Crochet

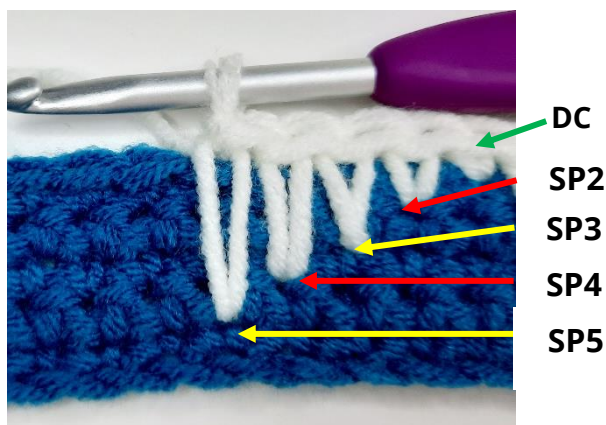
FPDC – Front Post Double Crochet

Spike 2 (SP2) – Insert hook in stitch 2 rows below (the top of the row 1 below previous row), yarn over (YO), pull through drawing loop level with other DC on working row. YO and pull through 2 loops.

Spike 3 (SP3) - Insert hook in stitch 3 rows below. YO, pull through drawing loop level with other DC on working row. YO and pull through 2 loops.

Spike 4 (SP4) - Insert hook in stitch 4 rows below YO, pull through drawing loop level with other DC on working row. YO and pull through 2 loops.

Spike 5 (SP5) - – Insert hook in stitch 5 rows below YO, pull through drawing loop level with other DC on working row. YO and pull through 2 loops.



Tension

19sts x 22 rows = 10cm in rows of dc.

SIZE

One size - 11cm wide from thumb cuff. 18cm in height from wrist to knuckle when laid flat.

When joining the new colour for the top and bottom cuff, always join it in the last ST made in the previous row. Use a mattress stitch when sewing the side together, this way no seam will be seen.

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Pattern instructions- make 2

With BLUE, Chain 37.

1. DC in 2nd CH from hook and in each ST across. Turn. 36sts.
2. - 5. CH1 - *does not count as a ST here or throughout entire pattern.* Make 1DC in each ST across. 36sts. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail.
6. Join WHITE on right side of work. CH1. [1DC, 1 SP2, 1 SP3, 1 SP4, 1 SP5] **7 times.** 1DC. Turn.
7. - 11. CH1. DC in each ST across. Fasten off yarn leaving along tail.
12. - 35. Rep rnds **6-11**, 4 times, changing colour each repeat in the order MUSTARD, WHITE, GREY, WHITE. *Place a ST marker in the 1st ST of Row 12.*
36. Join BLUE on right side of work and Rep rnd 6. Do not turn. SLST in 1st DC made to join the round. *(You will now be working in rnds).* (36sts).
37. CH1. DC in each ST around. SLST in the 1st DC made to Join. Fasten off yarn.
38. With MUSTARD CH1. * DC, FPDC. Repeat from * around. SLST in the 1st DC made to join. Fasten off yarn. 36sts.
39. With GREY repeat Rnd 37.

Bottom Cuff

1. Join MUSTARD with a SLST in the underside of the foundation CH - (Row 1). CH1. DC in each ST across. SLST in the 1st DC made to join in the round. 36sts.
2. CH1. * FPHTR, HTR. Repeat from * around. SLST in the 1st FPHTR to join. Fasten off yarn.
3. - 6. Rep Rnd 2 changing colour each rep in the order GREY, WHITE, MUSTARD, BLUE. Do not fasten off after BLUE rnd.
7. CH1, DC in each ST around. SLST in the 1st DC to join. Fasten off yarn.

Thumb

1. Join BLUE with a SLST in the marker ST on ROW 12. Working towards the top of the mitt and across the row ends, make 1DC in the next 12sts up the side of work. Rotate to work down the opposite side making 12DC across the row ends. SLST in the 1st DC to Join in the rnd. 24sts.
2. CH1. DC in each ST around. SLST in the 1st DC to join. Fasten off yarn.
3. With GREY, CH1, * DC, FPDC. Repeat from * around. SLST in the 1st DC to Join. Fasten off yarn.
4. With MUSTARD repeat Rnd 2.
5. Turn the mitt inside out and use the long tails ends to sew the open sides between the thumb and the cuffs closed. Fasten off and weave in ends.
