## Snowflake Square

**Hook Size: 4mm** 

Yarn: Deramores Studio DK 100% acrylic yarn.

250meters/ 273yards. Blue Haze (Blue) & White.

This pattern is written in US terms

<u>US Terminology</u> <u>UK Terminology</u>

SC – Single crochet DC – Double Crochet TR

SLST – Slip Stitch ST – Stitch sts - Stitches CH – chain

MR – magic ring



- 1. Using BLUE HAZE CH46. SC in the 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from the hook and in each CH across. (45 stitches here and throughout pattern).
- 2. 44. CH1, Turn. (Always CH1 for each row. CH1 does not count as a ST throughout entire pattern). SC in each ST across.
- **45.** Turn. (*Right side facing*). SC in each ST across with (SC, CH2, SC) in the last ST of the row. \* Turn work and make 1SC in each ST down the side of work with (SC, CH2, SC) in the last ST. Repeat from \* for remaining sides finishing in the last ST up the side with (SC, CH2) and SLST in the 1st SC made on the top row. Fasten off yarn.

## **Snowflake**

- 1. Using WHITE in a MR (2DC, CH2) 6 times. SLST in the top of the 1st DC to join. (12DC).
- 2. CH3 counts as 1st DC, DC.\* In the CH2 space make (DC, CH2, DC). 1DC in the next 2sts. Repeat from \* around. Finish with a SLST in the 3rd CH of the beginning CH3 to join. (24DC).
- 3. SLST in the next 2sts. CH3. \* In the CH2 space make (DC, CH2, DC), DC in the next ST. CH2, Skip 2sts and DC in the next ST. Repeat from \* around. Finish with CH2, skip 2sts and SLST in the 3<sup>rd</sup> CH of the beginning CH3 to join.








**4.** (CH1, SC), SC. \* In the CH2 space (SC, CH5, SLST in the 3<sup>rd</sup> CH from the hook, CH2, and SC back into the CH2 space. SC in the next 2sts. (Smaller snowflake point made).



In the next CH2 space (SC, CH4, SC in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> CH from the hook - (1<sup>st</sup> Point). CH5, SC in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> CH's from the hook - (2<sup>nd</sup> Point). CH5, SC in the 4<sup>th</sup> CH from the hook - (3<sup>rd</sup> Point). CH4 and SLST in the 3<sup>rd</sup> CH from the hook (*This will be the top point*).

CH5 and SC in the  $4^{th}$  CH from the hook. SLST into the remaining CH on the  $2^{nd}$  CH5 made –  $the 3^{rd}$  Point. CH5, SC in the  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  CH from the hook. SLST into the remaining CH on  $1^{st}$  CH5 made –  $the 2^{nd}$  Picot. CH4 and SC into the  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  CH's from the hook. SLST into the remaining CH on the  $1^{st}$  CH4 you made. –  $1^{st}$  point.

Make a SC into the CH2 space that you started in. (Larger snowflake point made). SC into the next 2sts and repeat from \* around finishing with a SLST in the 1st SC made. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail to sew onto square. Snowflake will have 6 long points and 6 shorter points. Pin onto centre of square and sew into place.
