

## Christmas Tree Square

**Hook Size : 4mm**

**Yarn:** Deramores Studio DK 100% acrylic yarn.  
Raspberry (Red), Orange, Peridot (Green), Lavender (Purple)  
Citrine (Yellow) Rose (Light Pink), Blush (Darker Pink),  
Blue Haze (Blue), Gingerbread (Brown).

**This pattern is written in US terms**

### US Terminology

SC – Single crochet  
HDC – Half Double Crochet  
DC – Double Crochet  
SLST – Slip Stitch  
ST – Stitch  
CH – chain  
MR – magic ring  
[ ] – pattern repeats.

### UK Terminology

**ALL stitches are SINGLE CROCHET, apart from the BOBBLE ST. ALL bobbles will be made on the wrong side of work.**

**R** – Red (Raspberry) single crochet  
**BB** – Brown (Gingerbread Bobble)      **GB** – Green (Peridot Bobble)      **PB** – Purple (Lavender Bobble)  
**OB** - Orange      **YB** – Yellow (Citrine Bobble)      **LPB** – Light Pink (Rose Bobble)  
**PB** – Pink (Blush Bobble)      **BLB** – Blue (Blue Haze Bobble)

- Using **RASPERRY** CH46. SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook and in each CH across. (45 sts here and throughout pattern).
- 3. (*CH1 and TURN – CH1 does not count as a ST throughout. Do this for each row*). Make **1R** in each ST across.
- 20R**, Change to colour **BROWN** in the 20<sup>th</sup> ST. Insert hook into the 20<sup>th</sup> ST and Pull up a **RED** loop. Then YO in **BROWN** and pull through. (**BB**, **1R**) 3 times. **BOBBLE STITCH** - (4DC's together). \* YO, insert hook, pull through, YO, and pull through 2 stitches. Repeat this \* 3 more times. You will end up with 5 loops on your hook, (*Colour change yarn to RED here*). YO and pull through all of the loops on the hook.



Remember to count the last 1R of the repeat in brackets before starting the next set of R single crochet stitches. **19R**. *DO not fasten off BROWN yarn, carry back across in ROW 5 instead.*

- Make **1R** in each ST across.
- 7. Repeat **ROWS 4 & 5**.
- 9. Repeat **ROWS 4 & 5**. Fasten off brown yarn.
- 8R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 15 times. **7R**. *DO not fasten off GREEN yarn, carry back across in ROW 11 instead. Do this for all remaining rows – less ends to sew in !*
- Make **1R** in each ST across. **DO this for every ODD ROW**.
- 9R**, [**GB**, **1R**] twice. **OB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] twice. **YB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] twice. **BLB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 3 times. **PB**, **1R**, **GB**, **9R**.
- 10R**, **GB**, **1R**, **PB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] twice. **LPB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 4 times. **YB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 3 times. **8R**.
- 11R**, [**GB**, **1R**] twice. **PB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] twice. **BLB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 4 times. **BLB**, **1R**, **GB**, **11R**.
- 12R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 7 times. **OB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 3 times. **11R**.
- 13R**, **GB**, **1R**, **LPB**, **1R**, **GB**, **1R**, **YB**, **1R**, [**GB**, **1R**] 4 times. **PB**, **1R**, **GB**, **13R**.



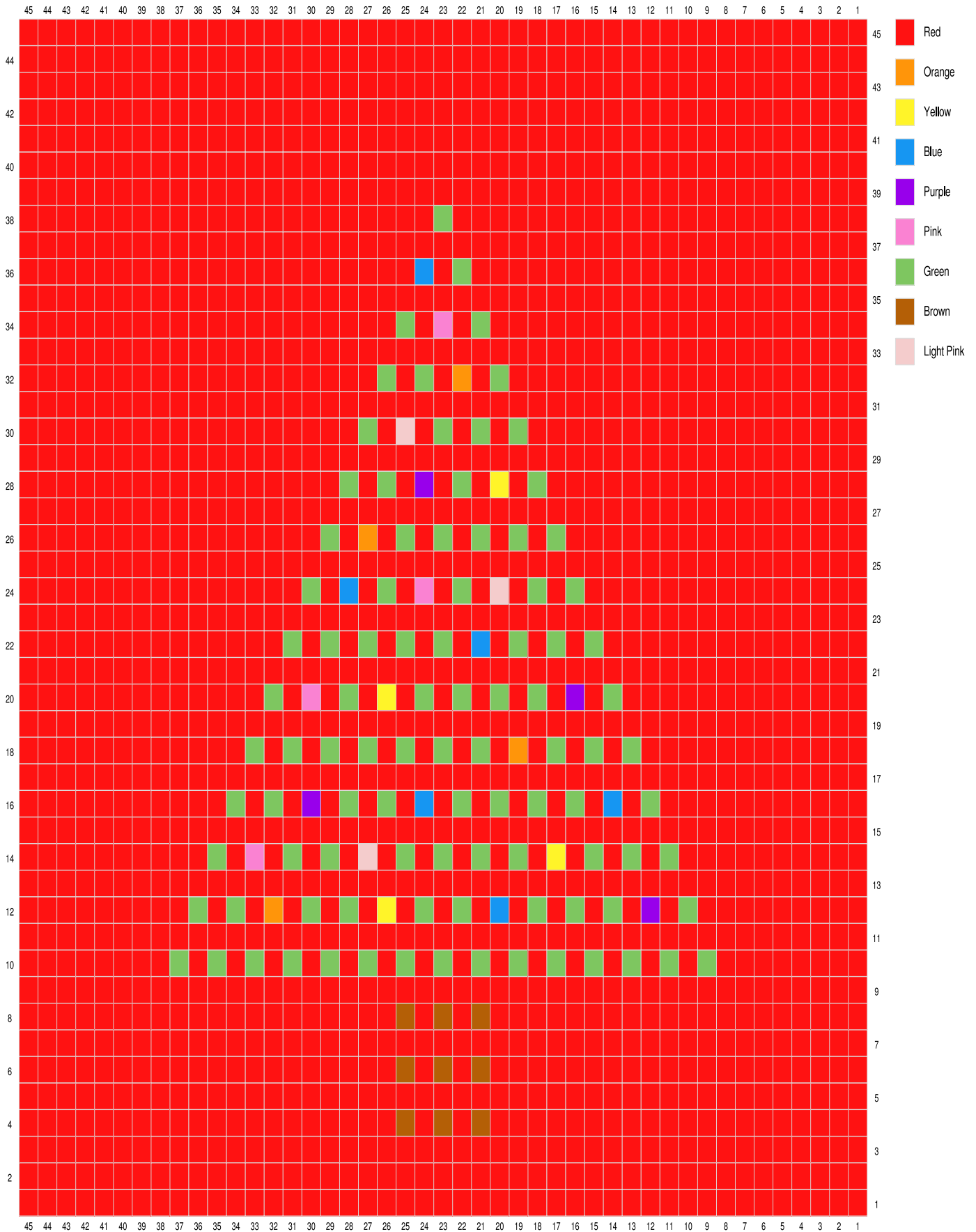
22. 14R, [GB, 1R] 5 times. BLB, 1R, [GB, 1R] 3 times. 13R.
24. 15R, GB, 1R, BLB, 1R, GB, 1R, PB, 1R, GB, 1R, LPB, 1R, [GB, 1R] twice. 14R.
26. 16R, GB, 1R, OB, 1R, [GB, 1R] 5 times. 15R.
28. 17R, [GB, 1R] twice. PB, 1R, GB, 1R, YB, 1R, GB, 17R.
30. 18R, GB, 1R, LPB, 1R, [GB, 1R] 3 times. 17R.
32. 19R, [GB, 1R] twice. OB, 1R, GB, 19R.
34. 20R, GB, 1R, PB, 1R, GB, 20R.
36. 21R, BLB, 1R, GB, 21R.
38. 22R, GB, 22R.
39. – 44. Make 1R in each ST across.
45. (SC, CH2, SC). Make 1SC in each ST around the outside edge of the square with (SC, CH2, SC) in each corner ST. SLST in the 1<sup>st</sup> SC made to join. Fasten off yarn

### Star

1. Using CITRINE in a MR make 5SC. SLST in 1<sup>st</sup> SC to join. (5sts)
2. (CH1 – *does not count as a ST throughout*, 2SC), Make 2SC in each ST around. SLST in 1<sup>st</sup> SC to join. (10 stitches).
3. (CH1, HDC, CH3, SLST in the 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from the hook, HDC), SLST in the next ST, \* (HDC, CH3, SLST in the 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from the hook, HDC), SLST in the next ST. Repeat from \* around. SLST in 1<sup>st</sup> HDC made to join. Fasten off yarn leaving a long tail. (5 points made). Sew on to top of tree on square.
4. Using GOLD sew 3 lines each side of the star. Then starting at the top make a zigzag line down the tree. Fasten off yarn.
